



CREATIVE SEWING WORKSHOP

Another well-attended creative sewing workshop was held on Saturday, May 21, 2022, on the premises of the Temporary Reception Center “Borići” in Bihać. After the members of the “Women United” Association, Šehrzada Hasanagić and Mine Šabić, showed how to make bags at the previous workshop, they demonstrated the ways of making decorative headbands at today’s workshop. In addition, Ms Hasanagić demonstrated the basics of sewing and tailoring to the people on the move from Cuba, Nepal and Iraq, who are staying in “Borići”. Apart from people on the move, the creative workshop was attended by high school students from Bihać, the representatives of the local community.

It should be reminded that the goal of the project „Enhancing social cohesion in host communities of people on the move” – attended by the members of the „Women United” Association and students of the Pedagogical Faculty – to acquaint people on the move to the cultural heritage of Bosnia and Herzegovina, as well as to acquaint the local community with the cultural heritage of the countries from which people on the move come. Today's meeting was an opportunity for those present to get to know each other better and present the country they come from.

The creative sewing workshop held at the center „Borići“ is a part of the project implemented by the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in Bosnia and Herzegovina, financed by the European Union’s Foreign Policy Instruments Service (FPI) under the Instrument Contributing to Stability and Peace (IcSP).
