Within the project “Enhancing social cohesion in communities with people on the move” implemented by the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in Bosnia and Herzegovina, lectures *Flora of Bosnia and Herzegovina in literature* and *Fauna of Bosnia and Herzegovina in literature* were held on Friday, May 13, 2022 in the Temporary Reception Center “Borići”. The lectures were prepared by Vildana Pečenković, Associate professor at the Pedagogical Faculty. Ajla Čaušević, a student at the Department of German Language and Literature at the Pedagogical Faculty, participated in the preparation of the workshop. Stories about animals and plants encouraged students and members of the “Women United” Association to present the beauty of “Una” National Park and the Una River in words and pictures.

After the lecture, which focused on stories about animals, workshops were held where the beneficiaries of the Center in Borići presented animals and plants from their homelands of Nepal, Iraq and Afghanistan.

This event was an opportunity for students and people on the move to get to know each other and, through stories about the beauties of nature, show that nature is what connects people no matter where they come from and where they go.
