



“FLOWER ISLANDS AT THE CAMP” – THE FIRST WORKSHOP

The first urban horticulture workshop planned within the project “Enhancing social cohesion in host communities of people on the move” implemented by the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in Bosnia and Herzegovina was held on Saturday, June 4, 2022. It was prepared by Samira Hotić, Assistant professor at the University of Bihać and a member of the “Women United” Association. The workshop was attended by students of the University of Bihać, people on the move from India, as well as members of the “Women United” Association from Bihać and Bosanska Krupa. At today’s workshop, the entrance to the building of the Temporary Reception Center “Borići” and the space next to the entrance intended for daily activities of people on the move were arranged with selected ornamental plants.
