



ETHNO EMBROIDERY WORKSHOP

The fourth creative workshop was held on Sunday, May 29, 2022. It was prepared by the members of the “Women United” Association. Apart from the local community representatives, the workshop was also attended by people on the move accommodated in the Temporary Reception Center “Borići”, originally from Somalia, India, and Iraq. The workshop of traditional handicraft – ethno embroidery was prepared by Ms Suada Harčević. Unlike the first workshop, where Ms Harčević demonstrated to the audience an embroidery on a panama (mesh cotton fabric) that reflects the cultural heritage of Bosnia and Herzegovina, she helped the beneficiaries of the center “Borići” to present traditional embroideries from India and Iraq.

The works created within the project “Enhancing Social Cohesion in Host Communities of People on the Move“, implemented by the International Organization for Migrations (IOM) in Bosnia and Herzegovina and financed by the European Union’s Foreign Policy Instruments Service (FPI) under the Instrument Contributing to Stability and Peace (IcSP), will be displayed at an exhibition planned after the workshops.
