INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

**(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people
on the move)**

The third lecture within the "Life Routes" project pointed out procedures that ensure a good coexistence of the local community and people on the move. Prof. Dr. Šejla Bjelopoljak led the attendees through the process of recognizing oneself in the Other and the Different, i.e. the local community in the community of people on the move. Prof. Dr. Bjelopoljak first encouraged those present to talk about what makes them special, their identity, and then to talk about the identity of the collective. The participants agreed that they were very similar in many ways, and what made someone special turned out to be often common to others as well. During the activity, students, pupils, and members of the "Women United" Association, who had never met before, overcame all barriers and extended hands of friendship to each other. In the end, it was concluded that the foundations of a good coexistence of the local community and people on the move are communication and mutual understanding.
