INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

**(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people
on the move)**

Telling stories is one of the greatest skills, and it was precisely the story that was the topic of the lecture held by Dr. Lejla Ovčina, Assistant professor at the University of Bihać. At this fourth lecture within the "Life Routes" project, students of the Pedagogical Faculty, members of the "Women United" Association, and high school students from Bihać told stories through which they got to know not only others, but themselves as well. Through personal narratives about friendship, reconciliation and forgiveness, an effort was made to show that love is the most important human emotion. During this activity, those present were also introduced to inspiring examples from world literature in which interpersonal relationships are questioned and compassion is encouraged. The goal of the lecture is to use the story to break down the prejudices and obstacles that surround us every day, especially the prejudices against people on the move.
