INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

Language and translation were discussed at the sixth lecture held as part of the "Life Routes" project. The lecture held by Mr. Sc. Nermina Delić was attended by the students of primary school "Harmani II" and members of the local community. The topic of the lecture, Language and translation, is the link between the intercultural dimension of language teaching and the broader thematic areas of education and socialization. During this lecture, students and teachers were introduced to examples that show the importance of language education. It was emphasized that, through language classes, students not only develop language skills, but also learn about social, cultural and political aspects of society, which makes them participants in shaping their community.

It should be noted that the school "Harmani II" was one of several primary schools in the area of Bihać where children from the migrant and refugee population attended regular classes for a time. In addition, the students shared their experiences and positive stories about their peers – children on the move with whom they shared school desks. The students stated unanimously that there were no obstacles in communication and that the school children from the temporary reception center "Borići" learned Bosnian very quickly and established friendships with their peers from Bihać. This activity is supported within the framework of the project "Individual measures to strengthen the response capacity to manage migration flows in Bosnia and Herzegovina", financed by the European Union and implemented by the International Organization for Migration (IOM).
