INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

With the lecture *Others in mine and I in the eyes of Others: How do we process social information?*, the first cycle of lectures within the "Life Routes" project implemented by the "Women United" Association and the Pedagogical Faculty of the University of Bihać has been completed. The lecture held by Dr Amela Mujagić, Assistant professor, was attended by students of the University of Bihać, as well as members of both the local community and the "Women United" Association.

Throughout the lecture *Others in mine and I in the eyes of others: How do we process social information?*, Dr Mujagić spoke about the importance of careful processing of social information in everyday life. By beginning to understand how processing information about other people affects our social behavior, the participants developed a deeper understanding of how to interpret social signals with more sensitivity and understanding. The lecture aimed to encourage each individual to recognize the value of thinking about people outside of social categories in order to build a better sense of connection and understanding. During the lecture, the participants shared their personal experiences on how to fight against stereotypes about people on the move. In this regard, we have presented the narratives created during the "International Grace United (United through cultures)" project – which is the „Women United” Association implemented in cooperation with the Pedagogical Faculty in 2022 in the Reception Center „Borići”.
