**(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people
on the move)**

The mosaic of interpersonal relationships that shape our everyday experience is at the core of every community. In this regard, Prof. Dr. Šejla Bjelopoljak held an inspiring lecture with the aim of sensitizing those present on the issue of interpersonal relations. Through an interactive format, participants are invited to explore more deeply the understanding of interpersonal relationships, especially in the context of migrant populations. Professor Bjelopoljak focused attention on various aspects of human interaction, stressing the importance of empathy, understanding, and support. One of the key goals of the lecture was to break down prejudices and stereotypes, as well as encourage empathy towards migrants as people who face challenges every day. Through dialogue and active listening, the participants became aware of the importance of solidarity and inclusiveness in creating a society where every individual feels accepted.
