INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

In order to wish people on the move a warm welcome and the opportunity to celebrate Eid together, the Association „Women United“ organized „Eid concert“ at the reception center „Borići“. Organized as a symbol of solidarity, the concert attracted a large number of migrants from all over the world who are currently staying in Bihać. The joy of Eid was shared by people on the move, members of the „Women United“ Association, and volunteers from the area of the Una-Sana Canton. The attendees had the opportunity to listen to traditional and modern songs, as well as to watch traditional dances. The famous Bosnian singer Emir Hasić participated in the event, presenting the richness of the cultures of this area through numerous songs. Apart from Mr. Hasić, members of the folklore group „Grmeč“ from Bosanska Krupa participated in the program dedicated to Eid. They presented cultural heritage with a mix of folk dances.

The Eid concert is another example of how joint effort and solidarity can create space for mutual understanding and friendship by spreading messages of tolerance in the community.
