INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

Education for peace is becoming ever more important in today's world, especially when viewed in the context of migration. In this regard, within the framework of the "Life Routes" project implemented by the "Women United" Association and the Pedagogical Faculty, a lecture "Knowledge, skills and attitudes as the basis of education for peace" was held. It was attended by pupils, students, teachers, and members of the "Women United" Association, and the lecturer was Mr. Sc. Nermina Delić.

During the lecture, the causes of migration were first presented – war, economic difficulties and climate change – and how these factors lead to the migration of people around the world. Understanding these causes helps reduce prejudice and increase empathy for people on the move. Then, the lecture focused on the skills necessary to support and integrate migrants into new communities. Finally, Mr. Sc. Delić spoke about the importance of attitudes such as tolerance, respect and solidarity that contribute to a more peaceful and inclusive society.

The goal of the lecture was to acquaint the attendees not only with understanding the complexity of migration and the challenges faced by people on the move, but also with actively participating in the creation of inclusive communities that value peace and justice.
