## **INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA**

### **(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)**

As part of the "Life Routes" project implemented by the Association "Women United" in partnership with the Pedagogical Faculty, a lecture titled "Civil, Interpersonal, and Professional Competencies in the World of Transition and Globalization" was held in Bihać. The lecturer was Prof. Dr. Vildana Pečenković, and the audience included members of the Association "Women United" and the local community.

In a world increasingly marked by rapid changes and global migrations, civil, interpersonal, and professional competencies are considered extremely important. Therefore, in the first part of the lecture, Prof. Dr. Pečenković, among other topics, spoke about the importance of tolerance in society, intercultural dialogue, lifelong learning, and individuals' participation in democratic processes.

Since the aim of this lecture was to highlight the importance of these competencies not only for the local population but also for people on the move, the second part of the lecture focused on presenting examples of best practices that facilitate the integration of children on the move into educational processes in the Una-Sana Canton. These examples were presented by teachers who attended this event.
