## **INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA**

### **(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)**

In the dynamic environment of the modern world, acceptance of diversity becomes a key issue in building an inclusive society. At the recently held lecture, Assist. Dr. Lejla Ovčina presented to those present various techniques aimed at supporting a society without discrimination, which accepts people regardless of religious affiliation, nationality, and social status.

Through dialogue, participants had the opportunity to explore multiculturalism and understand the importance of cultures in shaping identity. Assist. Dr. Ovčina emphasized the importance of open dialogue and intercultural communication as key elements in accepting diversity.

The focus was on developing techniques for accepting people regardless of differences. The lecture particularly highlighted the need to promote inclusiveness and equality in all spheres of society.

At the end of the lecture, the participants emphasized the importance of understanding and were encouraged to take an active role in promoting tolerance and peaceful coexistence among all people.
