INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

Within the "Life Routes" project, a second encaustic painting workshop was held at the PPC "Borići" on May 25, 2024. This ancient painting technique involving the use of colored wax has once again become a means of overcoming linguistic and cultural barriers. The workshop leader, Hajrija Mujkić, a member of the "Women United" Association, practically demonstrated how interesting paintings can be created with the help of wax and heat. Through the process of shaping artistic miniatures, migrants from Nepal, Morocco, Somalia, Syria, and Tunisia, as well as members of the "Women United" Association, showed that art is a universal language that everyone understands. Each painting became a story of cooperation and mutual understanding.
