



INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

The first knitting workshop was held in the Temporary Reception Center "Borići" as part of the "Life Routes" project. The workshop was attended by members of the "Women United" Association and migrant women from Syria, Somalia, Morocco, and Cameroon. The aim of the workshop was to encourage mutual understanding and exchange of experiences related to the skill of knitting.

Under the expert guidance of Dr. Sc. Minka Ćehić, an experienced knitter, the participants were taught different knitting techniques by making scarves and hats. It should be emphasized that the migrant women demonstrated the knitting skills they learned in their homelands, enriching the knowledge of women from the local community. The atmosphere was relaxed and friendly, which enabled everyone to get to know each other better. During the workshop, the participants talked about their "life routes", which contributed to the creation of a sense of community.

This first knitting workshop showed how working together on creative projects can bridge cultural differences and strengthen bonds within a community.

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
