INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

Digital nomads and contemporary migrations are topics discussed by Prof. Dr. Jasna Hamzabegović at a lecture held within the "Life Routes" project. Given that one of the goals of the project is to create an inclusive environment that encourages mutual support and cooperation between the local population and people on the move, this lecture emphasizes that digital nomads as well as people on the move can contribute to the progress of the community in different ways. Among other things, they can improve the local economy with their knowledge and skills.

The lecture covered the key aspects of the work of digital nomads, including flexibility in work, the use of modern technologies, as well as the challenges and advantages of this way of life. During the lecture, Prof. Dr. Hamzabegović pointed out the importance of digital nomads, which is reflected in stimulating the development of the economy, but also how the inclusion of people on the move can enrich the community with new knowledge, skills, and perspectives.

Students and members of the "Women United" Association actively participated in the discussion, presenting their thoughts on important issues, especially the impact of technology on modern life. This lecture is one in a series of activities aimed at promoting understanding and cooperation among different groups, creating a community that connects people.
