INDIVIDUAL MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE RESPONSE CAPACITY TO MANAGE MIGRATION FLOWS IN BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

(LIFE ROUTES - Understanding migration movements and supporting people on the move)

The end of the "Life Routes" project was marked with ceremonies held in Bihać. This project included numerous activities that enabled the local population and people on the move to get to know each other, cooperate, and form friendships.

The ceremonies in Bihać were an opportunity to summarize the results after six months of implementation of the "Life Routes". Prof. Dr. Jasna Hamzabegović, president of the "Women United" Association, presented the project results and thanked those who contributed to its success – the students of "Harmani II" Elementary School, high school and undergraduate students in Bihać, members of the "Women United" Association, and people on the move. On this occasion, certificates of appreciation were awarded to the participants and partners in the project implementation.

As part of the artistic program, members of KUD "Grmeč" from Bosanska Krupa presented a mix of folk dances from Bosnia and Herzegovina and Greece. After the ceremony held in Elementary School "Harmani II", another one followed – in the Temporary Reception Center "Borići". The members of KUD "Grmeč" presented folk dances from this region to the migrants located in "Borići".

With this project, Bihać and the entire Una-Sana Canton showed that true values are reflected in the ability to accept and support each other, regardless of where we come from and where we are going. The festivities are supported within the project "Individual measures to strengthen the response capacity to manage migration flows in Bosnia and Herzegovina", funded by the European Union and implemented by the International Organization for Migration (IOM).
